








WEST YORKSHIRE POLICE – FREIGHT CRIME CONVICTIONS






Details

- A delivery driver stopped in the northern part of Duisburg (suburb: Walsum), a km distance to the A59 motorway, to hand over a shipment
- On his return back he saw two men trying to steal freight from the vehicle


