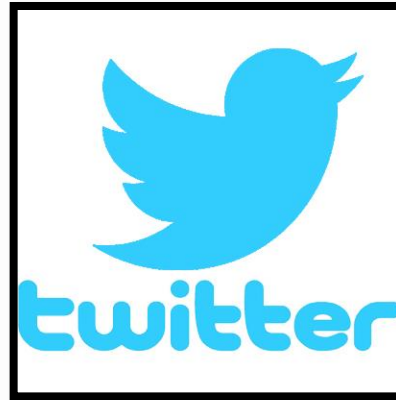

NaVCIS Freight are working with colleagues at Central Motorway Policing Group (CMPG) & West Midlands Police

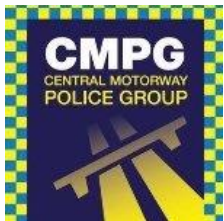

Overnight on Monday 30/03/2020 to Tuesday 31/03/2020, an incident occurred of a theft in transit of Cargo travelling from Durham to Tamworth

Possible Romanian Rollover Offence - This involves the offenders during the hours of darkness and with no lights displayed to avoid detection tailgating the HGV & semi trailer, climbing onto the bonnet of the pursuing vehicle to open the rear trailer doors to gain access & unloading contents while the vehicle is in motion

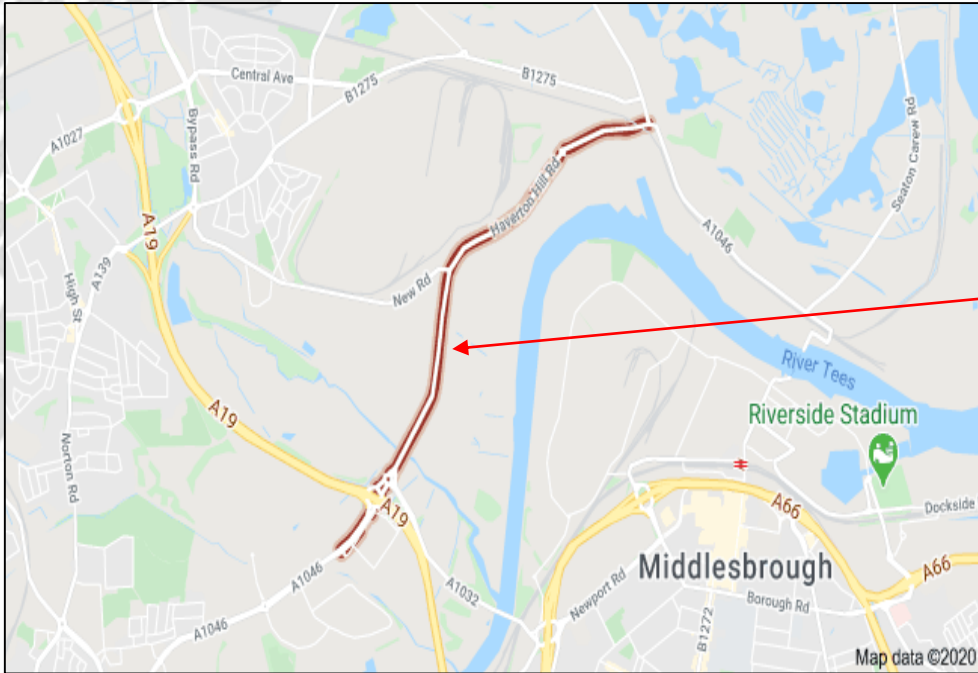
