During the early hours of Friday 09/04/2021 – a HGV Curtain slashing offence occurred in St Albans


Police responded from both Hertfordshire Constabulary & Bedfordshire Police and arrested two men from West Yorkshire



The Trailer was bound for France and due to carry electrical goods



NATIONAL BUSINESS CRIME SOLUTIONS – HGV "JUMP UP THEFTS"







NaVCIS are working with partners at National Business Crime Solutions (NBCS)

Since 01/04/2021 in Greater London – there have been SIXTEEN incidents of HGV "Jump Up Thefts"

"Jump Up Thefts" involve retailers lorries being entered either on route or whilst delivering goods which is known as the "Final Mile" in the Supply Chain

EUROPEAN DISTRIBUTION FRAUD – METAL PRODUCTS STOLEN



Code D of PACE

The following instructions must be followed by officers to ensure identifications can be actioned and are admissible in court. All persons viewing images must follow the below procedures, as you may be called to court to account for your actions. You must view the images alone, your identifications must be yours and yours only. If you recognise a suspect, do not discuss this with colleagues; send the information to the OIC as soon as possible

Your Identification statement must cover the below points:

- 1. Whether you were alone when viewing images, and if not the reasons why.
- 2. Image ref number.
- 3. Full details of subject as known to you.
- 4. Reasons for recognition i.e. facial features, gait, distinctive clothing or a combination of all.
- 5. How long you have known them.
- 6. How you know them.
- 7. Whether you recognise the place shown in the footage

NaVCIS – BRITISH PARKING ASSOCIATION



NaVCIS are working with partners at the British Parking Association in relation to safer parking facilities for HGV Drivers

The British Parking Association (BPA) is the UK's leading trade association for the parking industry.

BPA manages the Safer Parking Scheme (SPS): a Police-CPI (Crime Prevention Initiative) backed and approved UK-wide accreditation. The award is known as Park Mark; currently 15 lorry parks have this award. Public sector and private lorry parking operators interested in knowing about how the SPS might benefit your business operations and future plans for a specific lorry park award are invited to contact us.

A Park Mark is awarded to parking facilities that pass a rigorous risk assessment conducted by the police and the BPA area manager. The assessments include management and maintenance of the facility, ensuring that there are appropriate levels of surveillance, lighting, signage and cleanliness. These criteria are known to reduce the opportunity for crime and create a safer environment.

If the site achieves the award, the operator is entitled to display the Park Mark logo and is also featured www.parkmark.co.uk and the SNAP website.

Mark Stanojevic from Sutterton Truck Stop, awarded Park Mark in November 2020, said "This is a great asset to us; it lets drivers know we are serious about protecting them and their vehicles. To be the first truck park to receive the award in Lincolnshire is a fantastic achievement."
