Shoplifting

Its main aim is to provide information and advice to businesses, helping them to protect themselves from becoming victims of crime.

The below crime reduction tactics can go a long way to protecting you from shoplifters.

Top tips to prevent shoplifting:

- Greet your customers or make eye contact when they enter your premises. This way they know they've been seen
- Install appropriate CCTV facilities to act as a deterrent to potential thieves
- Signage to highlight the presence of CCTV can help further protect your business and staff
- Consider the layout of your premises always make sure high value goods are positioned in sight of the till or CCTV cameras
- · Display empty boxes in place of your high value goods and store products elsewhere
- · Use radios so staff can communicate and make observing a potential offender easier

- Remind staff to be vigilant and make sure they know who to contact for assistance
- Put a height marker near the entrance to help with descriptions of potential offenders and make it easier for other members of your team to identify them
- Be aware of large groups. Some shoplifters work together to distract staff by complaining loudly or asking to see the manager leaving others to operate freely
- Engage with local police officers and join a partnership with other retailers in your area. Working together could help you to identify repeat offenders and reduce your risk
